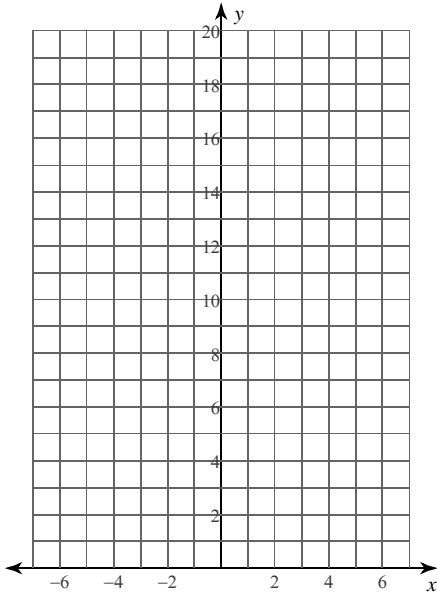


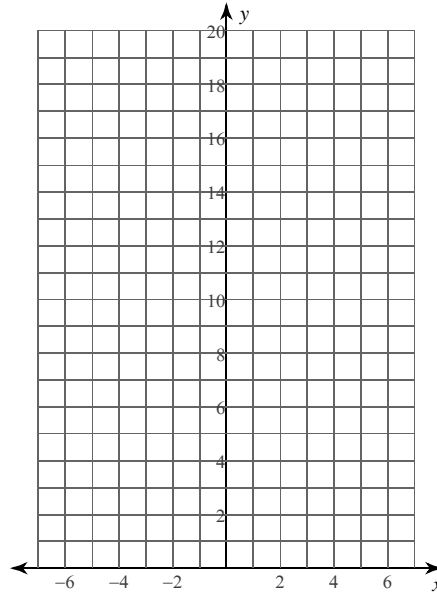

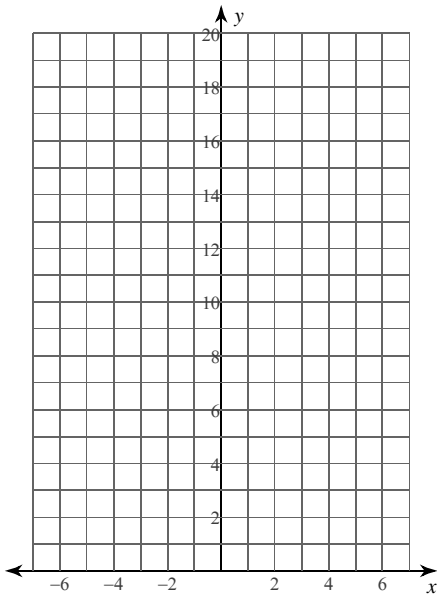
1) $y = \frac{1}{2} \cdot 5^x$



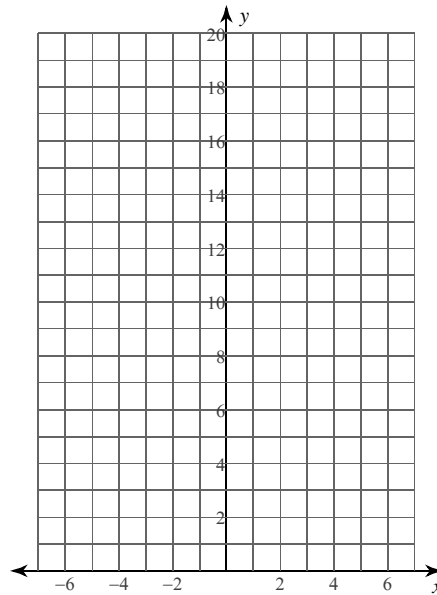
2) $y = \frac{1}{3} \cdot 2^x$



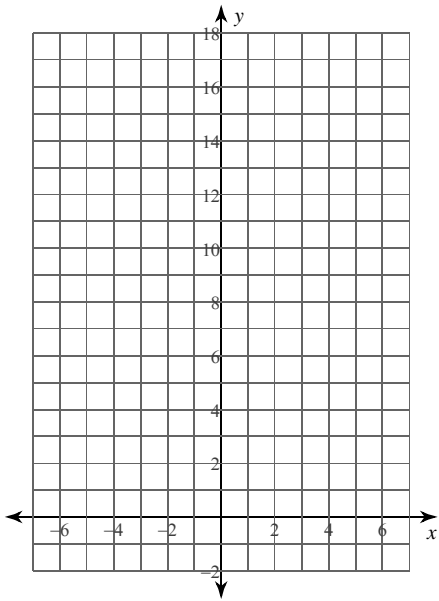
3) $y = 5 \cdot \left(\frac{1}{2}\right)^x$



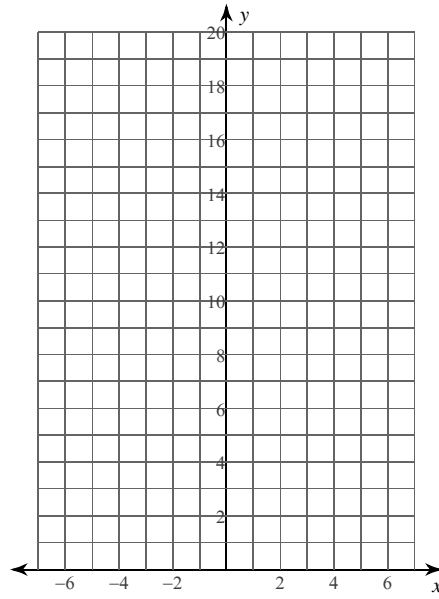

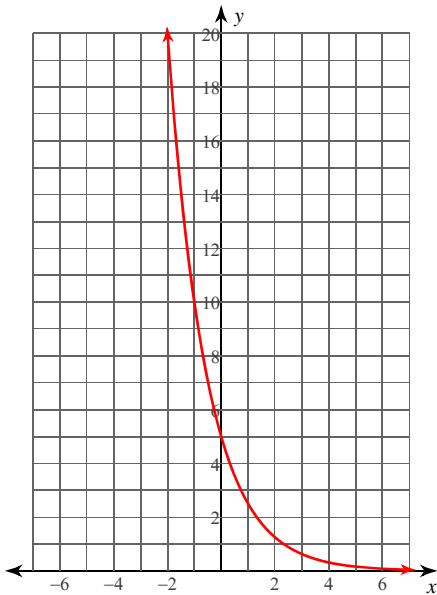

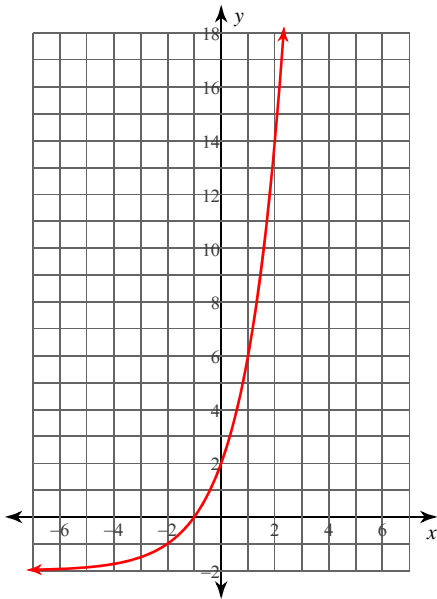
